Internationalized Registration Data Working Group (IRD-WG)

- Joint Working Group of GNSO and SSAC
- Study the *feasibility and suitability* of introducing submission and display specifications to deal with the internationalization of registration data

IRD-WG Final Report Recommendations

- 1. ICANN staff should develop, in consultation with the community, a data model for domain registration data.
- 2. The GNSO council and the SSAC should request a common Issue Report on translation and transliteration of contact information.
- 3. ICANN staff should work with the community to identify a Registration Data Access Protocol that meets the needs of internationalization.

Internationalized Registration Data Working Group Final Report - Next Steps

- IRD-WG Final Report submitted to the GNSO and SSAC for consideration and approval on 06 March 2012
- The SSAC revised and approved the Final Report on 27 April 2012
- The IRD-WG reviewed the revisions from the SSAC, revised and approved the report on 9 May, 2012
- The IRD-WG sent a revised version to the GNSO for review.
- Once the GNSO and the SSAC have approved the final version of the report the GNSO and SSAC will jointly submit it to the Board.

- Proposed an additional recommendation:

Recommendation 4: ICANN should take appropriate steps to require gTLD registries and registrars and persuade ccTLD registries and registrars to support the following standards ...
