RAA and Compliance



 At-Large remains concerned that insufficient funds for Compliance activities are being provided.


- ALAC has placed a high priority on this issue and strongly believes that adequate funding must be ensured.
- A Port 43 access test conducted during the Brussels meeting found almost 100 failures - clearly the WDPRS system integrity is of concern.
- A recent examination by an ALS in NARALO found 11 Registrars have "look up" service instead of WHOIS.

- The ALAC wishes to make particular note of, and give the highest compliments to, the timely preparatory work and Statement of the African ICANN community regarding Support for the New gTLD Applicants.
