## **N-CAP Objectives**

The objects of this society are to provide residents of Nunavut with access to and training on the internet and computer technologies by:

- Maintaining a network of Community Access sites where members of the public can use computers and the internet across Nunavut:
  - o maintaining a volunteer base to support each Community Access site; and
  - By securing such funding to provide support to each Computer Access site to be used to:
    - Secure personnel to maintain the sites.
    - Hire instructors to develop training courses
- To upgrade hardware, software and the sites in general, as necessary,
- To make training programs in the areas of technology, career development or economic development available to the public; or
- To complete projects to further the objects of the Society.
