

Technet Unit (NUS)




#### 1995

SGNIC formed. Took over Technet. Technet became Pacific Internet



#### 1997

SGNIC corporatised as subsidiary of NCB




#### 1999

IDA formed to take over NCB. SGNIC became subsidiary of IDA

### **.SG Domain Name Statistics**



Registry-Registrar model since 2002 Total = 130,000 names As at June 2011



### **Promotional Schemes**



- Buy-One-Get-One-Free
  - ➤ Buy a 3<sup>rd</sup> level, get a 2<sup>nd</sup> level free for one year
  - Most common bundle = .com.sg, get .sg free
- ILoveSG
  - Every August to celebrate National Day
- Hong Bao Promo
  - Implementing next year, every January/February
- Incentive Rebate Scheme
  - Volume discounts

### **Outreach to SMEs**



- SME Programme
  - Collaboration between SGNIC and the Registry of Companies (since 2007)
  - Available to SMEs who have not registered any .sg domain name before
    - SGNIC is waiving its fee for the first year of registration
  - Seamless system between Registry of Companies and SGNIC
    - Registrant reserves their name for up to 3 months
    - Activate their name at any participating registrar

# **On-going Activities**



- Enforcement Efforts
  - ➤ Daily checking of new registrations coming in to ensure that:
    - Eligiblity criteria is met
    - Contact information is as accurate as possible
    - No sensitive or offensive words are registered
    - This is done on top of the checking done by registrars
  - Work closely with other relevant agencies and also SingCERT

### **New Initiatives**



#### IDN ccTLD

- Sunrise Phase 1: 4 Jul Existing owners of Chinese domain names (IDN.sg)
- Sunrise Phase 2: 12 Sept TM holders, government agencies, other interested entities
- General launch: 13 Dec

#### DNSSEC

- Test-bed with registrars
- Public test-bed soon
- Singapore hosting the 3<sup>rd</sup> node for PCH-ICANN DNSSEC for ccTLDs programme
