#### 5. General discussion on revocation

#### 5.1. Section 3.5 of RFC1591

- 5.1.1. BS noted that there would need to be a procedure which would allow the incumbent to correct any inadequacies prior to any revocation procedures being undertaken.
- 5.1.2. There is no further information available in the documentation as to what "doing a satisfactory job of operating the DNS service for the domain" or "persistent problems with the operation of the domain" imply.
- 5.1.3. BT tasked with investigating if there is anything in the new gTLDs material which could assist the working group in this area.

#### 5.2. Section 3.4 of RFC1591

- 5.2.1. There is no further information available in the documentation as to what "substantially miss-behaved" of "IANA stepping in" imply.
- 5.2.2. BS noted that IANA "stepping in" probably implied revocation.
- 5.3. Section 7 of the GAC Principles 2005
  - 5.3.1. It is unclear if or how this ties in to the previous points.
