

- Phase 1 (2013): development of the beta platform content modules from existing materials – for trialling in Buenos Aires
- Phase 2 (2013/2014): integration of new content, creation and collaboration with the community and with partners in the Internet ecosystem - additional focus on functional (HR, finance, etc.) and thematic modules (IG, MS model, etc.)
- Phase 3 (2014+): additional functionalities and tracks







Methodology

The OLP is built around three elements:

- A Learning Management System platform
- Personalized portal incorporated into mylCANN
- Content that is organized into knowledge modules

Content Development

A set of module criteria will be established so that the knowledge modules will have a common and coherent structure for a consistent and familiar learning pedagogy

 Phase 1: existing materials (podcasts, presentations, etc.) will be structured into knowledge modules that will be stand alone but linked in terms of relevant thematic or functional focus areas

These modules will provide a good basic understanding of what ICANN's role is in the Internet ecosystem and IG, what its various constituencies do, and how and why one should participate

 Phase 2: Content modules will be created to address growing educational and training needs and will involve the community, as appropriate
