

.ORG DNSSEC

ICANN Seoul October 2009



- » .ORG approved by ICANN to proceed with DNSSEC June 2008
- » .ORG zone signed June 2, 2009
- » Largest gTLD to sign we felt this was a good signal to the industry to move from R&D to implementation



- » Over 30 domains signed to date. We have manually inserted the DS records at the Registry
- » Public-facing domains include: pir.org, icann.org, iana.org, isoc.org, isc.org, ietf.org, iab.org, irtf.org, iesg.org, sanog.org



» Registrars are participating in the testing phase

- 2 registrars have passed their certification test
- We are conducting a Registrar education program via webinar within the DNSSEC Coalition
- » Shinkuro and Sparta are testing and documenting domain transfers of DNSSEC signed domains within the OT&E environment

» Getting good operation practice with key rollovers



- » We expect to complete our internal testing by end of year 2009
- » Production launch targeting first half of 2010
 - Shift to enabling Registrars to submit live delegations
