Subject: Proposed Amendment to the .NYC Registry-Registrar Agreement

Dear Ms Papac,

Pursuant to clause 2.9(a) of the Registry Agreement executed between ICANN and The City of New York by and through the New York City Department of Information Technology & Telecommunications, we request approval to make changes to our Registry-Registrar Agreement. The changes being sought are to:

1. Introduce the concept of:
 - a. a Price List in Exhibit G, and consequential amendments; and
 - b. Premium Names;
2. Clarify the requirement for a Registrar to:
 - a. provide to us a copy of any End User Agreement; and
 - b. require the Registered Name Holder to expressly agree to the price of a domain name.
3. Ensure that requirements for Uniform Rapid Suspension are appropriately addressed.
4. Resolve a minor typographical error.

We respectfully request prompt review and approval in accordance with the procedures found at: <https://www.icann.org/en/system/files/files/rra-amendment-procedure-2Saug11-en.pdf>.
