Dear Janis and Keith,

Thank you again for joining us in Los Angeles last week. I hope you have been able to make optimal use of this time to plan for phase 2 of the EPDP Team's work. My team remains available should you have any further questions or require further information. As requested, I am hereby confirming my request to you and the EPDP Team for further collaboration in relation to the Unified Access Model (UAM) based on the model proposed by the Technical Study Group (TSG) on Access to Non-Public Registration Data.

As I have stated previously and reiterated during our conversation, the work that ICANN org has been supporting in relation to a UAM based on the model proposed by the TSG has as its objective to determine whether this would diminish the legal liability of contracted parties, who would provide access to non-public registration data. This in turn, is expected to inform the EPDP Team's phase 2 deliberations. However, during recent conversations it has become clear that before an answer can be provided, further work needs to be undertaken to help inform the discussions with the European Commission and Data Protection Authorities. As such, I would like to request that the EPDP identifies a small number of representatives who, on behalf of the EPDP Team, would work with ICANN org, to move forward these discussions. I expect that this work will also further help inform the EPDP Team's deliberations.
