Internet Society NGO is a non-for-profit organization working according to the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia (RA), International agreements of RA, its charter and it is registered in Yerevan, Armenia.

Describe your Organisation's structure (e.g. governing and decision-making bodies and processes): The highest body of the organization is the General Assembly (GA), which is called by the Council according to the needs but at least once in a year. Beyond the GA meetings, the organization's governing and executive body is the Council, which is elected by GA. The president of the ISOC AM is elected by the GA for a period of three years and with the right to be reelected. The director of the organization is assigned by the Council of the organization. The ISOC AM has also an auditing committee elected by the GA for a period of one year.

From now on, all members of the ISOC Armenia Chapter should also be members of the Internet Society. They register in the Internet Society website and after becoming a global member, they indicate for membership in the Armenia Chapter. Once they mention the Armenian Chapter, the online application request comes to the Chapter administrator for approval. Then, the member needs to pay the annual membership fee equivalent of 3 USD and the ISOC global member becomes the member of the Chapter.

- g. In what language/s does your Organisation conduct its business? The official language in the RA is Armenian. Legal records are in Armenian, while the communication languages among ISOC AM members are English, Russian and Armenian.
