


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DNSSEC Compliance Trend for all Federal Agencies (March 2011 – March 2012)




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DNSSEC Compliance Trend for all Federal .GOV Domains (August 2011 – March 2012)




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DNSSEC Improvement Trend (July 2011- March 2012) Number of Compliant vs. Total Number of Domains




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DNSSEC VALIDATION

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Summary of DNSSEC .GOV Uptake

(April 2011 – March 2012)

- **36% increase** in the number of **compliant Agencies**.
- **40% increase** in the number of **compliant domains**.
- **43% decrease** in the number of **non-compliant domains**.
- **\$25,625 saved** due to elimination of 205 unused domains.
