Trademark Clearinghouse

- A repository for trademark data supporting rights protection mechanisms offered by new gTLD registries
- Replaces need for trademark holders to register in many databases as TLDs are launched




Clearinghouse Functions

- Performing verification of trademark data
- Maintaining database of verified trademark data
- Supporting new gTLD mandatory rights protection mechanisms (RPMs)
 - Sunrise (pre-launch)
 - Trademark Claims (post-launch)

Introduction

The Clearinghouse will provide marks holders with the following services:

- Trademark verification services
- Sunrise Services
- Trademark Claim Services
- Dispute Resolution Services
- ☐ Customer Support
- Other Services (TBD)

Registration with the Clearinghouse



Registration – Eligibility requirements

- □ Agent acting on behalf of a trademark holder or a trademark holder that is a holder of:
 - A nationally or regionally or registered trademark
 - US trademark, EU trademarks, etc.
 - Trademark must be registered in accordance to the national laws at the time of verification
 - Court validated marks
 - Unregistered trademarks, well-known protected marks
 - Marks protected by statute or treaty
 - Geographical indications, designation of origin, names relating to the International Olympic Committee and the Red Cross/Red Crescent
 - Statute or treaty must be in force before or on 26 June 2008
 - Other marks
 - To be determined

Registration – Eligibility requirements

■ Not Eligible

- Any mark starting with or containing a dot (.)
- Any registered mark that was subject to successful invalidation, cancellation or rectification proceedings
- Any intellectual property rights which cannot be represented within the technical limitations of the Domain Name System (e.g. patents, designs, etc.)

Proof of Use



Proof of Use – Sunrise Services

☐ Principle:

- Only necessary for registered trademarks
- Completed declaration and a sample of use needs to be uploaded

☐ Sample of use:

- Acceptable:
 - Labels, tags, or containers from a product
 - Advertising and marketing materials (including brochures, pamphlets, catalogues, product manuals, displays or signage, press releases, screen shots, or social media marketing materials)
- Unacceptable:
 - Inclusion of a mark in a domain name
 - Email messages
 - Licenses to use a mark
 - Business cards

Proof of Use – Sunrise Services

- □ Declaration and a submission of a current sample of use: once every five (5) years to maintain sunrise eligibility
 - Annual renewal of the TM record will only require re-submission of a new sample when the sample is no longer eligible
- □ Upon verification of the trademark data and proof of use (when applicable):
 - Sunrise code/file will be generated.
 - Sunrise notifications will be sent to the trademark holders/agents with a corresponding domain name, when a domain name with a *sunrise code/file* has been registered.

Matching Rules



Matching Rules

- □ Applicable to both Sunrise Services and Trademark Claims Services
- □ "identical match" = domain name consists of complete and identical textual elements of the mark
 - E.g.: icann => icann.test
 - Not included: plurals and "marks contained"
 - "icann ex" NOT => icann-exes.test
 - "icann ex" NOT => icann.test
- ☐ Additional criteria to constitute an identical match
 - Spaces, punctuations or other IDN-impermissible characters(!, +,= etc.) may be omitted or replaced by hyphens
 - "icann ex"/ "icann.ex"/ "icann_ex => icannex.test /icann-ex.test

Matching Rules

- Exception to the rule above: special characters @ and &
- May be replaced by a hyphen, omitted or translated
 - Translation based on the applicable official language(s) corresponding to the language of the jurisdiction

Dispute Resolution



Dispute Process – Correction Process

- □ All trademark holders/agents will be able to correct any trademark information that has been marked as incomplete/incorrect by the Clearinghouse
- ☐ Free of charge (one time)
- □ After the correction process → trademark record is still incorrect or does not meet the Clearinghouse guidelines → Invalid

Grounds for Dispute

- ☐ Any trademark holder/agent that does not agree with the verification.
- ☐ Any third party that does not agree with the verification.
- □ Any third party that has become aware of any new information that has an impact on a valid trademark record.

Protect your trademark in the new gTLD era

What is the Clearinghouse?

With potentially over a 1,000 new TLDs on the internet, ICANN designed the Clearinghouse as a single database of authenticated registered trademarks to protect brands and their intellectual property rights. Brands will have a one-stopsolution that will safeguard their domain name during multiple pre-registration periods in the new gTLD program. For example:

- Trademark holders will be able submit their trademark information to a centralized repository.
- After verification, the trademark holder will be able to register its corresponding domain name during the pre-registration period of multiple TLDs - also known as the "Sunrise period".
- Trademark holders will also have to option to be notified when someone registers a domain name that matches their record in the Clearinghouse.

The Clearinghouse is implemented by Deloiste and IBM in accordance with the Request for information issued by ICAMN on October 3, 2011, Deloiste Enterprise Risk Services (a department of Deloiste Sedrijforevisoren BV ovve CVBA) will serve as the authenticator and vidators service provider; whilst IBM (International Business Mashines of Belgium spri / bvba) will provide technical database administration services.

Who can apply?

Any trademark holder, private person, or company can submit their trademark to the Clearinghouse. The Clearinghouse will accept, authenticate, and verify any registered trademarks, marks protected by statue, treety, or court validated
