A sponsored TLD proposal  
for the Catalan linguistic and cultural community

# Why .cat?

- Internet is the most powerful communication's tool. And most COMMUNICATIONS are carried through LINGUISTIC MEANS
- There is a (relatively) large Internet community articulated around Catalan language and culture
- TLDs identify services/people/... and add a specific label, according to varying principles: profession, area of activity, territory, legal form, economic branch.... We propose language & culture as ONE of those criteria

# You said... Catalan?

- Catalan is not that marginal.. in relative terms
  - 11 milion speakers (8th language within EU)
  - Strong cultural presence (books, TV, newspapers, Universities...)
  - 23rd language on the Net
    - The first one you wouldn't expect, in any case ;-)
- Strong support: 73 representative entities + over 60.000 supporters!
- In fact, Catalan is a unique case

# Our main goals

- Provide a domain name identifier to a seizable community wanting it
- Reinforcing Catalan-language related content on the Net (it would not force it, but it would help...)
  - Psychological effect inside the community
  - Visibility outside the Community
- Reinforcing long-term survival of catalan as a tool for social and cultural communication
- Allow ICANN to show support for cultural diversity and linguistic sustainability

# .cat is not...

- A TLD based on territorial or political criteria
- A proposal for creating TLD for each linguistic or cultural group
  - large number of speakers
  - written/cultural/communicational standards
  - strong Internet presence
  - spoken across many ccTLD territories
- A TLD for... felines ;-)

# Who's for? Eligibility Criteria

- A) Privileged registrants
  - Academia; Publishers; Writers; Media; Cultural promotion entities...
- B) Proof of current online activities
  - Corporations/Professionals/Individuals currently using Catalan in their online communication services
- C) General applicants: social networking
  - 1 "sponsor" from type A or 3 from type B (with email-based verification)

# ENS, Compliance and Dispute Resolution

- Eligibility criteria, Declaration of Use and Code of Conduct
  - Charter Compliance Procedure: ex-officio & upon complaint
  - Charter Reconsideration Policy
- CEDRP & UDRP
- Mediation (specially-selected DR provider)
- Defensive registrations (not that relevant, in our view...)

# IDN

- Few “special” characters:
  - à; é; è; í; ï; ó; ò; ú; ü; ç; l.l
- Simultaneous registration of ASCII equivalent
  - a, e, i, o, u, c, l-l
  - If ASCII equivalent is already taken by other registrant, no IDN registration
- 2x1: Same “registry life”; single price
- “Reversible” and intuitive alternative for users



# WhoIs puntCAT

- Associació puntCAT: vehicle for the application
  - Founding members: ISOC-CAT; IEC; CCRTV
  - 73 highly representative entities (language; culture Internet)
- If successful, would be run by a Foundation
  - Academia; Publishing & Media; Commercial users; Non-Com Users; .cat individual registrants
  - Advisory Committee & Public Forum
- Registry Operator: CORE

# Registering a .cat

- Through ICANN-accredited registrars
  - additional requirements on contractual language (provided) and IDNs
- EPP (plus web-based & client)
- Registry fee €75 + €25 for successive years
  - €50: Eligibility Naming (ENS) Services fee
- All ENS performed by Sponsor, not registrars
