Trademark Issues

- IRT formed at direction of the Board to recommend solutions to Trademark issues in new gTLD implementation
- The IRT developed Preliminary and Final Reports recommending seven specific solutions
- The reports were published for public comment and are now presented for community discussion with the goal of...
- Discussion regarding the effectiveness and 'implementability' of the suggested solutions (for inclusion into the new gTLD process)



Consultations and Communications

- We are in the middle of a process
- Complete scheduled consultations in different regions, encourage participation
- Get a sense of support of the recommendations and suggestions for improving them
- Ask IRT members and community experts for potential changes to the recommendations given the results of the consultations
- Staff to come back to the board at the end of consultations, options for strategy going forward, and straw man model for public comment

Approach to Recommendations

- For each recommendation:
 - Gauge support and potential amendment based upon community consultations
 - Review potential changes with former IRT members and other community experts
 - Perform cost/benefit analysis and devise implementation plan as required
 - Determine policy implications for each of the recommendations
- Write report for community comment: suggesting changes to the Guidebook for discussion
