Document deadlines (Katim Touray)

- Document deadlines now in place
 - Split 10 and 15-day deadlines for Sydney
 - Committee charged with creating policy for Seoul
 - Looking at a single 15-day deadline
- What should deadline cover? Agendas?
Presentations?
- Are the ACs/Sos prepared and/or able to meet such document deadlines?

Language (Jean-Jacques Subrenat)

- Both lingo and use of English still an issue
 - More translation, more interpretation each year
 - Question Box in multiple languages
 - Pioneering use of interactive video transcripts
 - New announcements process
 - Working on multilingual front page
 - Committee to be charged with developing process for Executive Summaries of documents
- What issues are not being addressed?

Public comment process (Thomas Narten)

- Public comment period overload?
 - Number of periods have jumped; but not followed by number of comments
 - Do we reduce number? How?
- Approach taken – does it need revisiting?
 - What are the requirements?
- Feedback – are you getting enough?
- Rules and procedures – are they clear?

Public forum (Thomas Roessler)

- More two-way discussion needed
 - Two lines of microphones to enable issue-based discussion
 - Give remote participants and new participants priority?
 - How to get away from series of statements
- How can we encourage more of the community to take an active role?
- Board interaction
 - More dialogue needed between audience and Board

Electronic tools (Mike Silber)

- Existing tools
 - Chatrooms, websites, Adobe Connect, video, audio, question box, Twitter, open microphones
 - What works well, what does not?
 - What role do open formats play?
- Is there a limit to effective remote participation?
 - Tools ICANN is not using?
 - What improvements can be made?
- Website usability study
 - Linked to on front page – advise people to take survey
