
#### At a Glance

- The Transfer Policy is a consensus policy that went into effect in 2004.
- Purpose of the Transfer Policy: provide a straightforward procedure for registrants to securely transfer their domain names from one registrar to another.
- Previous policy work recommended the Transfer Policy be reviewed following the implementation of all recommendations.
- Represented WG began meeting in May 2021.
- WG currently working through Phase 1A charter questions, which includes questions on the Auth-info code, Losing FOA, and Gaining FOA.

- For those interested, the WG is holding a working session at ICANN72, on Tuesday, 26 October 2021 at 10:00-12:00 (PDT).



#### At a Glance


• Initiated in May 2021 and first started meeting in August 2021.

#### Focus of the EPDP is on:

- the definition of all gTLDs and the management of variant labels to facilitate the delegation of variant gTLDs in the root zone while achieving the security and usability goal of variant labels in a stable manner; and
- how the IDN Implementation
   Guidelines, which Contracted Parties
   are required to comply with, should be
   updated in the future.
- The EPDP takes into account existing work, including the IDNs related recommendations from SubPro

#### At a Glance

- GNSO Council formally adopted the formation of and instructions to the Team on 22 July 2021.
- Scoping Team will consider current enforcement and reporting of accuracy, measurement of accuracy, and effectiveness of accuracy to scope issue.
- The Team's considerations are expected to inform its deliberations and development of recommendations to the GNSO Council on whether changes are recommended to improve accuracy AND the process by which such changes should be developed.
- Each SG, Constituency, SO, and AC has been invited to appoint <u>representatives</u> to this effort.
