# Outcome - Public Comment and ICANN84 session

Scoping	Most Commenters agree to move ahead with “unrestricted API access” as priority issue for policy development.	Most Commenters agree to move ahead with “Associated Domain Check” as priority issue for policy development.	Most Commenters prefer two separate PDPs with each issue having its own charter.	Commenters were divided whether “DGA Coordination” issue should be addressed via policy development or best practice.
Charter Questions	a) Focus on APIs that are used for registering domains, b) Consider API use is common in reseller models, c) Account for undue burden that such barriers to accessing APIs could pose to new registrants.	a) obligations should be scoped to ensure it is practical for both retail and wholesale registrars, b) clear criteria for what constitutes “association” c) Conduct DPIA and HRIA	Many commenters suggested to start with ADC as first PDP followed by addressing API Access.	Commenters asked how will the issues not mentioned as priority topic be treated in the future.
Other Considerations	Commenters noted that API access is part of the problem but the root of the problem is “high-volume registrations at once”.	Commenters noted complexity of codifying this practice into a policy that is both clear and enforceable.	Some commenters suggested to consider Open Model and/or allow for more seats/alternates.	“Recourse Mechanism” and “Contact Verification timeline” suggested as other priority topics by some commenters.

# Areas of Agreement - Proposed Updates to Report

## Two priority Topics

Community agrees that the ADC and API access should be addressed now and will have highest impact in addressing DNS Abuse.

## Two PDPs

Community prefers 2 separate PDPs aka 2 Charters. Community notes that parallel PDPs are too resource intensive. Suggestion to connect stagger them.

## Charter Considerations

Community agrees that the Charter already covers many important aspects but added further considerations to be reflected in the Charter.

## Issue 3

DGA Coordination preferred as PDP by commenters. To be addressed at later stage.

# Proposed Charter Considerations

## Associated Domain Check

- Consideration of complexity of codifying this practice into a policy that is both clear and enforceable
- Consideration of data safeguards and privacy principles.
- Security Consideration regarding sharing too many details in public might be counter productive.

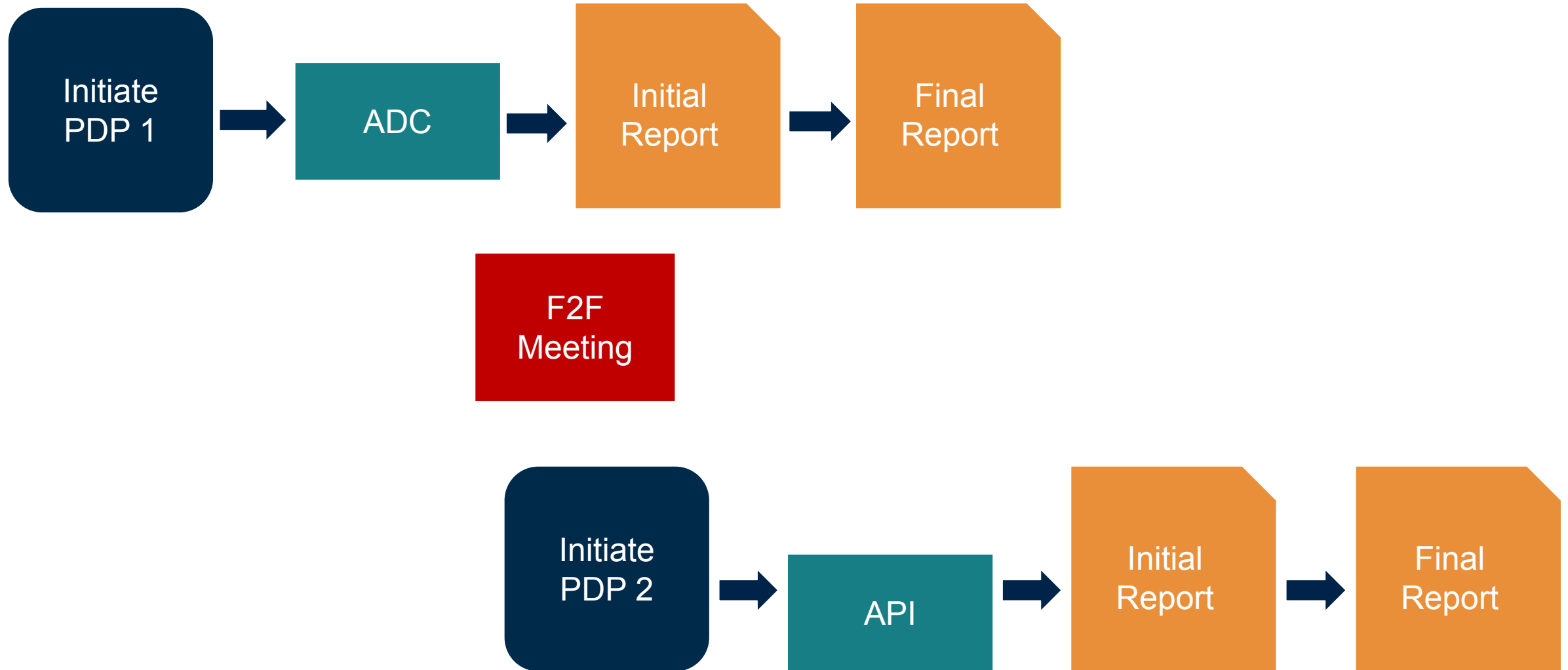
## Unrestricted API access

- Consideration of potential undue burden on new registrants.
- Consideration of a baseline of accountability and operational standards that registrars must impose on downstream partners.
- Consideration of establishment due diligence, monitoring, and enforcement obligations related to API users, resellers, or relevant third parties.

# Issue 3 – DGA Coordination PDP or not?

## Considerations:

The establishment of ICANN as Clearinghouse can happen outside of a PDP. Public Comment, however, suggested that this should be considered for policy development.

## **Proposed Way Forward:**

Update the Issue Report to reflect the above.

Issue Report will continue to propose two issue for a PDP.


Issue 3 can be pursued by the GNSO Council as seen appropriate.
