Council Accuracy Small Team Recommendation 2*:

The Council Accuracy Small Team recommends the creation of clear and user-friendly **educational materials** that could be provided before, during, and after domain name registration to assist registrants in understanding (i) the importance of providing and maintaining accurate registration data through the lifecycle of their domain name(s), (ii) how their personal data is processed and protected, and (iii) the consequences of providing inaccurate data or not verifying email/phone under the required timeline. The Small Team does not prescribe how these materials are created, but recommends assembling a diverse and representative group of interested stakeholders to work together on developing the recommended content for the materials.

*Note: This is NOT a policy recommendation - it is a Council Small Team Recommendation.
